

**KOSHKONONG TOWN BOARD MINUTES**  
**MAY 10<sup>th</sup>, 2006**

Chairman Swart called the May 10, 2006 town board meeting to order at 7:00 PM at the town hall with Supervisors Carol Clavey, John Debereiner, Randy Harris, Jae Ames, and Clerk Brigetta Nelson were present. Treasurer Judy Almquist was late.

Harris/Debereiner made a motion to open board of review to a later date. Carried.

Ames/Clavey made a motion to adjourn board of review until a later date. Carried.

Sheriff Department made the town aware of a string of burglaries going on throughout the county.

**Building Inspector:** Possibly add commercial building permits, change residential addition to read permit is required on 1,000 sq ft of total area, and questioning whether the Town wants to go back to issuing driveway permits. Board will act on these issues at next months meeting.

**Laub and Horton:** Rob Krohlow went over the 2006-2007 insurance policy. Clavey/Harris made a motion to go with Laub and Horton for a premium of \$9,351.00. Carried.

**Plan Commission:** Ames/Debereiner made a motion to support the planning commission's denial for Jeff Begovats' conditional use permit for a duplex at PIN 016-0514-1612-006, Maxwell Way Subdivision. Carried.

Ames/Clavey made a motion to approve the amendments to Appendix A with the removal of the uncertain column. Carried.

Harris/Debereiner made a motion to have the clerk contact the Wisconsin Towns Association to add the Chairperson of the Plan Commission to their mailing list. Carried.

**Black Hawk Boat Club:** Ames/Harris made a motion to approve the temporary class B liquor license for August 12, 2006 with a rain date of August 26, 2006. Carried.

**Fire Call Letters:** Swart/Clavey made a motion to deny the request not to have to pay the fire call at W5773 N Ra-Le Drive, due to the fact that they were called out because of a possible gas leak. Carried.

Swart/Harris made a motion to allow Donald Kraus not to pay the fire call for the Tree Fire on Hwy N South of Burnt Village, due to that Don followed all procedures. Carried.

Ames/Swart made a motion to have the clerk send a letter to the Fort Fire Department and Jefferson County Sheriff Department stating that the town cannot collect the \$750 for the fire call due to the fact that the sheriff and fire department didn't call the resident prior to going out to the call. **Adopt Resolution for Voter Registration Deputies and Elections:** Swart/Clavey made a motion to table until next month for more clarification. Carried.

**Set a date for a closed Meeting:** Swart/Debereiner made a motion to set the date for the closed meeting on May 17<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 PM. Carried.

**Review Employee Handbook:** Swart/Clavey made a motion to discuss the employee handbook at the May 17<sup>th</sup> meeting. Carried.

**Metal Locator:** Ames/Debereiner made a motion to rent a metal locator when it is needed. Carried.

**County Board Act 100:** Swart/Harris made a motion to be in favor of a 27 member board after the 2010 census. Carried. Ames abstained due to the fact that he works for the county.

Swart/Clavey made a motion to move to agenda item ditch in Twin Knolls. Carried.

**Ditch in Twin Knolls:** Swart/Debereiner made a motion to give the homeowner up to 26 ft culvert with a 12" arch done per the town board on May 10, 2006. Carried.

**Edgewater Road:** Ames/Clavey made a motion that if the City were willing to plow Edgewater Road and Dexhiemer for the next 10 years at no charge, the Town would not be opposed to the annexation. Chairman Swart will check into this. Carried.

**Groeler Road:** Since the town has not had any response to the letter we sent, the Town will go in, remove the culverts, and charge the property owner.

**Rock River Coalition:** Clavey is going to check with Barb Groesch to see if she can put it on the next agenda for the Wisconsin Towns Association Meeting.

**Aids Network:** Ames suggested that we table until will get a response to our letter.

**Road Work:** Place on next months agenda.

**Deputy Clerk:** Clavey/Debereiner made a motion that if the clerk is not available Judy Almquist will be the first choice for Deputy Clerk and if she is not available that Rhonda Cook will be Deputy. Carried.

Swart/Debereiner made a motion to approve spraying in the Park not to exceed \$500.00. Carried.

**Ramesh Shah:** Swart/Clavey made a motion to have Ames speak with the town attorney to see if the agreement is still in tacked and put on May 17 agenda. Carried.

**Treasurer's Report:** As of April 30, 2006 the account balances are as follows: Checking Acct \$453.41, Tax Famma \$2,500.00, Gen Savings \$2,663.00, Repo Agreement \$790,423.46, Passbook Savings \$10,878.76, Landfill Acct \$443.36 for a total of \$807,361.99. Income received in April, Trailer Fees \$37.81, Dog License \$1,643.00, Jefferson Cty \$8,690.75 (Culver Aid), Jefferson Cty \$6,794.00 (Road Advance), State of WI \$32,273.11 (Hwy Aid), Misc \$20.00 (phone call), Running at Large \$50.00, Building Inspection Fees \$2,612.50, Special Assessment Letters \$60.00, Plan Comm. Fees \$300.00, Tax Recoveries \$511.98, Repay Collection Fee \$40.00, Savings Acct Int \$1.92, Tax Acct Int \$1.92, Repo Acct Int \$2,901.28. Receipts total \$55,938.27 with disbursements \$186,316.26. Clavey/Debereiner made a motion to place the April report on file. Carried.
